- Sandile Thusi (Argyle) Road from Berea and North Beach

- NMR Avenue into Isaiyah Ntshangase (Walter Gilbert) Road for permit holders only
- NOTE: Umgeni Road into Isaiyah Ntshangase Road closed

Where should you park?

Limited parking available from 9:00. Unreserved parking at R20.00 per vehicle available at the following areas:

P Moses Mabhida Stadium External Parking Area

Get there from Battery Beach Road and Sandile Thusi (Argyle) Road.

Note: If you park in the Moses Mabhida Stadium external parking areas, please exit onto Sandile Thusi (Argyle) Road to avoid congestion.

P King's Park Swimming Pool - Very Limited

Access from Battery Beach Road via Masabalala Yengwa (NMR) Ave and Snell Parade. Virgin Active Classic Club members access for free on presentation of membership card after 14h00.

P Moses Mabhida Stadium Retail Basement Parking - Permit entry only

Access via Isaiyah Ntshangase (Walter Gilbert) Road from Masabalala Yengwa (NMR) Avenue.

P Moses Mabhida Stadium Suiteholders and VIP parking - Permit holders entry only

Access via Masabalala Yengwa (NMR) Avenue opposite King's Park Swimming Pool.
